There will be a celebration of life for Maxine at a later date due to COVID.






Project Completed!

First Presbyterian Church Endowment Committee

On February 11, the Endowment Committee met with Security National Bank to review our Church's investment portfolio. Despite the roller coaster year in the market, our investment portfolio experienced an 11.22% return, generating \$55,322 in income and \$144,782 in additional market value. We now have over \$1.9M in funds available for future church needs. Acting on the recommendation of the portfolio advisors and evaluating the future market indicators, the Endowment Committee members recommended transitioning the investment portfolio from a 60% equity / 40% bonds and government securities to a 65% equities / 35% bonds and securities balance. In addition, the Endowment Committee has recommended that the first \$500,000 in invested certificates of deposit (CD's) that matures this year be moved to SNB and invested in the same manner as the balance of the investment portfolio. The remaining \$600K+ will be reinvested in short-term CD's to address more immediate funding needs of the Church as they surface. Both the Finance Committee and the Session approved these actions at their respective February meetings. What is Holy Week?

Like many Christians throughout the world Presbyterians celebrate Holy Week which begins on March 28th with Palm Sunday.

Palm Sunday is the Sunday before the Friday Passover on which Jesus was crucified. The day signifies the time Jesus Christ entered Jerusalem, where he was welcomed by the people as their Savior. They shouted "Hosanna, (which means "save") Blessed is the One who comes in the name of the Lord. However, he would soon be betrayed and crucified by the same people who worshipped him.

The day takes its name from the tradition of using palm branches in acting out Jesus' entrance in Jerusalem. It is said that the people threw palm branches at his feet upon his arrival.

On <u>Maundy Thursday</u>, Christians remember the Last Supper--when Jesus had his last meal with his disciples. The day is also known as Holy Thursday, Covenant Thursday, Great and Holy Thursday. It is the beginning of a solemn three-day period of remembrance. Traditions that are reenacted at this time also include the washing of feet.

According to scripture, Jesus was betrayed by Judas, one of his disciples, and subsequently arrested. He was then tried and sentenced to crucifixion. Good Friday is observed in remembrance of this time. It is a day of somber commemoration.

Holy Saturday symbolizes the day Jesus Christ's body lay in his tomb. For this reason, it is also quite solemn. This day marks the last day of the Holy Week, which is immediately followed by Easter Sunday, a day of celebration.

On Easter Sunday, Christ's Resurrection is celebrated as the center core believe of Christian and Presbyterian beliefs. Following 40 days of Lent and 8 days of solemn reflection during Holy Week, the church rejoices in our Savior's victory of sin and death. Celebration.





Sound Technician First Presbyterian Church Sioux City, Iowa Job Description

Purpose:

<u>Reports to:</u>

To be responsible for the operation, care and maintenance of the sound system. The Sound Technician is accountable to the Pastor as Head of Staff and to the Director of Music.

<u>Responsibilities:</u>

To operate the sound system at regular worship services. Weddings, funerals, special services, concerts/recitals, etc. as requested.

To place, test, and adjust all microphones prior to use, including all cordless equipment.

To coordinate use of sound system with pastors, organists, pianists, instrumentalists, choir directors, children's music director, soloists, or whomever is to use the sound system.

To stay current on specifics of the use and operation of the sound system.

To attend requested practice sessions of choir, weddings, special programs, etc. when requested.

To assist in the maintenance of the sound system.

To make recordings available to the church office for hospital patients, shut-ins and etc.

To upload weekly sermons to the church website.
