The LORD is king, he is robed in majesty; the LORD is robed, he is girded with strength. He has established the world; it shall never be moved; your throne is established from of old; you are from everlasting.

Psalm 93:1-2

Friends, we know what a kingdom is. It's a country that's ruled by a king or queen. We've understood what kingdoms are like since we first heard about them in fairy tales about rulers wearing their royal crowns, sitting on royal thrones in their royal palaces. Of course nowadays we live in a democracy ruled by elected officials, while even in the United Kingdom, the monarch is more of a royal figure-head without much real power. And yet there are still countries today where one monarch holds absolute sway over the lives of their people.

Part of understanding the Bible is knowing that the writers had to put God's words in terms that people could understand. So they often made theological statements using imagery, comparing heavenly things above to earthly things below. And while God's reign far surpasses the power of any earthly leader, comparing God to an earthly sovereign helped those writers make that point.

[Jesus] said therefore, 'What is the kingdom of God like? And to what should I compare it?

Luke 13:18

From September until Advent begins, we'll spend our worship services exploring what Jesus had to say about the kingdom of God. Even Jesus chose to teach people theological truths by using imagery of royal majesty and undeniable power. And yet Jesus was trying to help people understand a kingdom unlike any other.

The kingdom of God is a place where the least and the most humble, like servants and even children, are the greatest; where we can't enter without being born again. It's as small as the smallest mustard seed and as valuable as the greatest pearl. It's where people are overjoyed to receive generosity and grace, but it's also a place that doesn't bear excuses. It's a place where everyone is called, but few answer. It's a kingdom that we must be prepared to accept, even while it is being prepared for all of us who call Jesus our Lord and Savior.

We have a lot to learn about this kingdom. But we are blessed by the fact that all of these descriptions come from our King Himself. Jesus even taught us one of the most surprising things about this kingdom. While even Jesus sometimes portrayed the kingdom of God as something we'll attain at the ends of our lives, or at the end of time, Jesus also taught that, for those of us who declare that Jesus is our Lord, that kingdom is already here!

'The kingdom of God is not coming with things that can be observed; nor will they say, "Look, here it is!" or "There it is!" For, in fact, the kingdom of God is among you.'
