Friends,

There are many Christmas movies (I've preached sermons about some of them!), but not many movies about New Year's Day. My favorite is a comedy by Joel and Ethan Coen called "The Hudsucker Proxy". It's a movie about second chances, and the hope that each New Year may be better than the last. The movie begins on a snowy New Year's Eve in America's hope-filled days of the 1950's. We see a view of the New York City skyline, centering on the Hudsucker Tower, the setting for most of the film. Hudsucker Tower is topped by a giant illuminated clock and the company's motto, written out in glorious, art-deco styled neon lights: "The Future Is Now."

One of the things I love about this movie is that (spoiler alert) it has a happy ending. Yet when we look ahead, some of us have difficulty seeing happiness in our future. Rev. Ralph Abernathy was a civil rights leader and close friend of Martin Luther King. In fact, while preparing to support a strike of Memphis sanitation workers, the two men shared Room 306 at the Lorraine Motel the night before King was assassinated. For his tireless work for civil rights, Abernathy endured years of arrests and imprisonment, beatings, death threats, and the bombing of his church and his home. But looking back on all of this, Abernathy still managed to find hope for the outcome of all his work. Abernathy famously said, "I don't know what the future may hold, but I know who holds the future."

*For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope.*

Jeremiah 29:11

The One who holds the future, of course, is the Lord God Almighty. No matter what future we're facing, we can take assurance in our faith that God will be there with us, and will get us through it. God's plans for our future are based on God's love for us; on God's desire to guide us and provide for us, to protect us and honor us. This same God has even planned for our future beyond our natural lives, giving us a savior, Jesus Christ. By Christ's resurrection, we have the promise of an eternal future in the glorious, loving presence of the Lord.

Friends, this New Year, like every New Year, is a new chance for all of us. A new chance to get closer to God in our prayers, our worship, and our understanding of the Bible. A new chance to forgive others, and to allow ourselves to be forgiven. A new chance to find God's calling for us. A new chance to serve willingly, to give joyously, to live abundantly, and to love God and each other. God has been planning this future for us since before we were born. Thanks to God, our future is full of hope and promise. And friends, the future is now!

We have an account with Petal Pushers in North Sioux City and they deliver them to us every Friday and then once I receive the invoice from the florist I will send you an invoice for your flowers. You can take them home with you or you can have the deacons deliver a bouquet to a shut-in. The cost is typically \$35 a bouquet but you can reduce or increase that amount to your liking. Please consider taking one or two Sunday's a year.
