Friends.

In his short story, "The Devil and Daniel Webster", Stephen Vincent Benet created the legend of what would happen to someone who went to Daniel Webster's grave and called out his name:

"...after a while you'll hear a deep voice saying, "Neighbor, how stands the Union?"
Then you better answer the Union stands as she stood, rock-bottomed and copper sheathed, one and indivisible, or he's liable to rear right out of the ground."

Webster was a statesman whose work to maintain this nation's unity delayed the Civil War for years. He was a patriot early in our nation's history, when many Americans were still trying to figure out what it meant to BE an American. If anyone would have been proud to wave the red, white and blue, it would have been Webster.

But not everyone who waves a flag is such a patriot. This being an election year, we're starting to be swamped with images of politicians waving flags, bunting, and starspangled balloons; callously doing everything but wearing an Uncle Sam costume to convince us that they are, as Stephen Colbert quipped, "Americans for a more American America." May we be able to reject such false patriotism as God rejects false worship:

"You hypocrites! Isaiah prophesied rightly about you when he said: 'This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me…"

Matthew 15:7-8

This pastoral letter has been adapted from one I wrote just a month after one of more poignant honors in my ministry. I led memorial services for one soldier who had been killed in action in Afghanistan. As Christians, we are assured that our honored dead who lived in Christ rest with God. But does this soldier's grave speak any less eloquently than Daniel Webster? In his memory, shouldn't we constantly be asking ourselves, "What is the status of this nation for which this young man died? How stands the Union?"

"Therefore I intend to keep on reminding you of these things, though you know them already and are established in the truth that has come to you. And I will make every effort so that after my departure you may be able at any time to recall these things."

2 Peter 1:12, 15

As we celebrate our nation's birth, let us put our faith in patriotism where it truly belongs; not with politicians who put on the flag like they put on that day's necktie, but with those whose constant love of their nation led them to give everything. Let us live in a way that will honor those who have paid this terrible price. Let us perform our patriotic duties, as well as enjoy our patriotic freedoms, in ways that would show to those who have gone before us that this nation is worthy of their sacrifice. And if anyone should ever ask, "How stands the Union?" may we be able to answer truly, "The Union stands as she has always stood. One nation, under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."

### Director of Christian Discipleship First Presbyterian Church Sioux City, Iowa Job Description

Title: Director of Christian Discipleship

**Purpose:** Serve the Christian Discipleship ministry with comprehensive oversight of programs and volunteers dedi-

cated to the ongoing Christian formation of children, youth, their parents, and other adults within the con-

gregation contributing to the overall mission of First Presbyterian Church, Sioux City.

Reports to: Pastor, Christian Discipleship Committee

#### **Responsibilities:**

Identify and coordinate curriculum choices for Sunday school, Vacation Bible School, Adult Bible Study and Confirmation in conversation with the Christian Discipleship Committee.

Recruit and train teachers/volunteers for Sunday school and VBS. When a Sunday school teacher or volunteer is unavailable on any Sunday, the Director should be prepared to take their place that day.

Develop and lead training for the participation of children and younger youth in worship as acolytes and bible carriers.

Work with our Children's Choir director to feature children's musical talents in worship.

Work with outside Christian educators to plan, promote and participate in multi-church events.

Promote upcoming Christian Discipleship activities well in advance via bulletins, newsletters, texts, emails, and/or social media.

Recognize and thank leaders and participants in Christian Discipleship activities.

Work with the Christian Discipleship committee to arrange an annual budget.

Lead annual performance reviews for Creche attendants.

Will keep sufficient supplies available for teachers.

Will provide direct supervision, planning, and implementing of:

- Sunday Church School
- Children's music activities
- Supervision and staffing of the Crèche for all services and meetings

Other duties as necessary.

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

Experience teaching and/or leading Christian Education/Discipleship programs.

Background check is a requirement of employment.

#### **Physical Requirements:**

Able to move freely in and out of different congregational settings (homes, church, businesses).

Able to speak in a public setting

#### Work Hours:

Part Time position including required hours every Sunday morning 9:00 - 11:30 during school year. Ensure Sunday School goes smoothly, be available to all the teachers, and supervise the crèche.

Required attendance of monthly staff meetings and Christian Discipleship committee meetings.

Office Hours as necessary.

Does this sound like you or anyone you know? Please send them our way. They can stop into the church office or call Karen to have an application mailed to them. We'd love to grow our classes.

The Member Care Committee is looking for people willing to knit or crochet prayer shawls. There are instructions for both knitting & crocheting in the church office. What is most important is the final size! The shawl should be approximately 4 feet long by 2 feet wide. Each shawl will take 3 skeins of yarn. Thank you!

Youth group activities to begin this fall


