#### Pastor Mark wanted to share this message from Barb Davis as his message for this month.

Moving to Sioux City over 13 years ago when I married Craig, one of my first priorities was to join a church. I grew up in the United Methodist Church and joined the Presbyterian Church (USA) when my boys were small. I knew my marriage had a better chance of success if Craig and I attended worship together, so I joined St Mark Lutheran Church (ELCA). Craig had been attending for years, and his children were baptized and raised at St Mark. I joined the Choir right away and participated in other areas of the church, but it never felt like home. After two years, I visited most of the Presbyterian churches in Sioux City. Each experience was different, but First Presbyterian felt like home from the beginning.

When you joined First Presbyterian Church Sioux City, what did you need from the church?

What do you need from your church today?

Did you know that we have a membership of 350 and average 60-80 in worship each week? We are blessed every single week by those 60-80 faithful souls.

We offer worship, Sunday School, Bible Study, Lenten Lunches, Chancel Choir, Handbell choir, children's choir, Lenten luncheons, Wednesday Night Supper and so many more opportunities for fellowship.

We have a pastor who is not only preaching sermons which teach us about God and make us laugh, but who is open to new ways to reach out to our community as God's people in downtown Sioux City. Pastor Mark is a breath of fresh air and a disciple of Christ in our midst. He is as human as we are and reaches out in friendship to all whom he encounters.

We have an aging church which the Buildings and Grounds Committee, Finance and Administration Committee, our Endowment funds, and our Memorial Committee have repaired and refreshed over the past two years. There is much yet to be done.

We fell short of our budget by \$75,000 last year due to diminished giving by our membership. With a budget of about \$474,000 again this year, the share for each of us is only \$1,354. That is less than \$30 per week. For those who are unable to give, we have many who give extra.

What do you need from First Presbyterian Church today

to bring you to worship or fellowship with us on a regular basis?

Here are my top reasons for belonging to First Presbyterian Church and attending regularly:

Worship weekly centers me, reminds me why I exist, and renews me for the week to come.

It is our right to give Him praise and thanks. With abundance comes gratitude and the more gratitude I show Christ, the more he blesses me.

As a disciple of Christ, worship renews my commitment to go and serve the Lord. He speaks to me through worship of the path he wants me to take.

I get to sing! Singing is essential to my mental health and general well-being. Our anthems often move me in ways the written word cannot.

My family is here. While I am not related by blood or marriage to another soul at First Presbyterian, I am united with them through faith and friendship.

I find a purpose in the mission I serve at First Presbyterian – through the Member Care Committee and through Session.

Each lesson learned in worship, Bible study or fellowship, brings me closer to Christ.

What do **you** need from First Presbyterian Church <u>today</u> to bring you to worship or fellowship with us on a regular basis?

If you are not counted in those who regularly worship or fellowship at First Presbyterian Church, Sioux City, I encourage you to reach out. Call Pastor Mark at the church, call me or any other Elder, call someone. Tell us what keeps you away and what we can do to serve you in Christ. If you just got out of the habit of attending, I challenge you to pick a Sunday and come back. Give First Presbyterian time through Christ's blessings to also bless you.

The Mission Committee meets on the third Sunday of each month. The next meeting will be April 16th after worship.






Missions' latest project was for Sleep In Heavenly Peace. Our congregation did an amazing job!!


