The wind $^{\pm}$  blows where it chooses...but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes.

So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit.'

John 3:8

People react differently to getting gifts. Some, like my wife, can walk past a stack of wrapped presents and not think anything of it. I even have to remind Beth to open her presents on her birthday, sometimes just so I can find out what's in them! But when I receive a wrapped gift, I have to try to figure out what's in it. Is it big? Is it heavy? Does the package rattle like a box of Legos? IT'S LEGOS, ISN'T IT?!? Since I was a kid, I couldn't wait to open a present, to solve the mystery of what someone had given me.

Our faith has set aside a time to contemplate the mystery around a different sort of birthday present. After Easter, we entered the season leading to the Day of Pentecost. On that Sunday (May 28<sup>th</sup> this year), we'll be celebrating the day when God's Holy Spirit came to Jesus' disciples. This is when they became apostles, led by the Spirit out into the world to spread the Good News of Jesus the Risen Christ. This day is often declared to be the birthday of the Christian Church. This is the same Holy Spirit which Jesus promised to everyone who put their faith in him. But it's also the least understood person of the holy trinity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It seems even more confusing when the Bible alternately describes God's Spirit as the wind (or the breath of God), as the dove that flew above Jesus at his baptism, and as the fire that appeared on the disciples on the day of Pentecost.

John answered all of them by saying, 'I baptize you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming...

He will baptize you with\* the Holy Spirit and fire.'

Luke 3:16

During our worship services and our Adult Bible Studies this season, we'll be learning more about how God's Spirit lives and works in us. We'll learn about how it is as gentle and powerful as the wind, as alive and unpredictable as a dove, and as burning and uncontrollable as fire. But in the Holy Spirit, God asks us to open ourselves to the most basic element of faith; there are aspects of God that we are not meant to understand. Mystery comes with faith, no matter how distressing that may be to those of us who feel like we HAVE to understand! But our faith in God should also help us accept that a mystery is okay. Like a wrapped gift, we may not know exactly what the Holy Spirit is. But coming from the One who loves us, we have faith that it is good.

With all wisdom and insight he has made known to us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure that he set forth in Christ, as a plan for the fullness of time, to gather up all things in him...

Ephesians 1:8-10


