Some of you may already know that I'm fascinated by building design. When I was younger, I loved to look at blue-prints and to learn about how those designs were turned into real structures. I'm especially interested in how churches are designed and built, from their cornerstones to the crosses on top of their steeples. And if you come by my office, you can see pictures of the cathedral I made from Legos!

But apparently, I'm not the only one who's interested in building. In addition to using images of such everyday occupations as farmers and shepherds, the Bible also uses builders and the buildings they construct to illustrate our spiritual lives.

Everyone then who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise man who built his house on rock.

The rain fell, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on rock.

Jesus, in Matthew 7:24-25

Over the next few weeks, we'll spend our time in worship exploring what goes into building a church, and how those different elements relate to our own lives as Christians. We'll talk about walls and how to make them strong. We'll talk about the steeple and why it's built to be so tall. We'll talk about stained glass windows and what they mean to us. We'll talk about the pulpit and what its purpose is. We'll talk about the altar and what makes it holy. And most importantly, we'll talk about the most fundamental part of any building, with the words of the apostle Paul:

According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it. Each builder must choose with care how to build on it. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 3:10-11

And there will be one more thing to add to all this talk about foundations and walls, stained glass, and steeples. In addition to all this imagery about buildings that represent our spiritual lives, there is still one building element that is necessary to make a house a home. It's not something that can be bought at the hardware store or the lumber mill. God's Holy Spirit is what has brought all of us together. It inspires us to build this Church up, and to build each other up. It is the nails and the concrete that takes all of us, as well as everything God has provided for us, and holds us all together. The Holy Spirit is what makes us more than just a building. It makes us a church.

Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? ... For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.
