Friends,

...one of his disciples said unto him, "Lord, teach us to pray..." And he said unto them, "When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name..."

From Luke 11:1-2 (King James Version)

Friends,

Before a NASCAR race in 2011, a pastor named Joe Nelms caused a sensation as he delivered the invocation. In the prayer, he thanked God for brands of cars and auto products. He used a line from a Will Ferrell movie, thanking God for his "smokin' hot wife". Nelms then stole racetrack commentator Darrell Waltrip's catchphrase, finishing with "In Jesus' name, boogity, boogity, boogity, amen!" Many people speculated on whether this was a "good" prayer. Was it appropriate? Was it irreverent?

Part of my ministry is to encourage our congregation in all of our spiritual practices, including prayer. That's why I try to encourage people, during meetings or classes, to volunteer to pray. When I do, however, there's usually a moment of awkward silence. Some people don't wish to pray in public because they're afraid they'll look foolish. I hope that we can all take assurance from Pastor Nelms' prayer that there are no "wrong" words to say when we pray. However, I will say that there is a right attitude to prayer. Prayer should be heartfelt and sincere. Prayer should be pure in heart, aimed toward God without prideful concern for impressing anyone else. And even when we pray about our fear, our anger, or our grief, prayer should also be reverent.

From our All Saints' Day remembrance on October 29<sup>th</sup> through Thanksgiving, we'll dedicate our worship services to different kinds of prayer. We'll cover prayers of adoration, confession, thanksgiving and supplication or, more simply, "Wow!" "Oops!" "Thanks!" and "Gimmie!" I hope that as we explore all these ways of praying, we can all find our own voices, in every situation, to speak with the Lord.

Friends, let us pray with faithfulness, knowing that God wants to be in touch with us, even if our words may seem plain. God has given us every resource we need. As we read above, Jesus has given us the basic template of how to pray. And God's Holy Spirit helps us pray even when we cannot find words ourselves.

Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but that very Spirit intercedes with sighs too deep for words.

Romans 8:26

As for Pastor Nelms, his prayer, while unexpectedly challenging, had some great qualities. If you watch a video of the prayer, you cannot deny his enthusiasm. He expressed the joy that God could create through that auto race for participants and spectators alike. And for once, everyone in attendance was LISTENING to the prayer!

Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup>pray without ceasing, <sup>18</sup>give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. <sup>19</sup>Do not quench the Spirit.


