Friends,

"The Lord Is Coming." Those mysterious words are vague enough to leave room for a lot of interpretation, and that interpretation would often depend on someone's own view of what they had coming to them! Many times during the history of the people of Israel, they knew they were falling short of the glory of God, but they wouldn't do anything about it. Often it took the words of a prophet to make them remember the consequences of forgetting their covenant with God. Imagine parents on vacation leaving their teenaged kids alone in their home. The kids start to party with their friends, doing everything their parents told them not to do. Then they get a phone call from their parents who say they're coming home RIGHT NOW! That's often how the people of Israel felt when a prophet like Isaiah told them, "The Lord Is Coming."

For the LORD will come in fire, and His chariots like the whirlwind, to pay back His anger in fury, and His rebuke in flames of fire. For by fire will the LORD execute judgment, and by His sword, on all flesh;

from Isaiah 66:15-16

This may be why, as the Gospel of John says, the world did not know or accept Jesus when He came into the world (John 1:10-11). He was simply too different from what they'd come to expect from the coming of the Lord. He was humble. He was gentle. Yes, the Lord was coming, but in Jesus Christ, the Lord was coming to offer wonderful things. The Lord's judgment was coming; not the judgment of the powerful over the oppressed, but God's perfect judgment, with righteousness, equity, and truth for all people. The Lord's righteousness was coming; not our own flawed attempts to be good people, but the undeniable righteousness of God's love and grace. The Lord's king was coming; not a king to rule over us as a tyrant, but to stand beside us as an ally and friend. So this new, different coming of the Lord would call for the kinder, gentler imagery which we have come to associate with Emmanuel; "God with us".

... say to the cities of Judah, 'Here is your God!' See, the Lord GOD comes with might, and His arm rules for Him; His reward is with Him, and His recompense before Him. He will feed His flock like a shepherd;

from Isaiah 40:9-11

Friends, this is one of the fundamental messages of Advent; in Jesus Christ, the Lord has come. But as Christians, we know we can interpret this message as "tidings of comfort and joy." The Lord has come into this world, bringing God's righteousness, God's inheritance, and God's salvation for all of us. And just as it has been for us every year of our lives, this is still Good News!

Sing and rejoice, O daughter Zion! For Io, I will come and dwell in your midst, says the LORD.
